The Application Process

Applications will be accepted from January 1 through April 20, 2012. The advisory committee will use the following criteria in making its selections:

- Personal *concern* about the future economic health and quality of life in Maine and a *commitment* to take actions to shape that future;
- Demonstrated *capacity to lead*; and
- A record of *accomplishment* within an organization and community endeavors.

Please recognize that your application is the only information the advisory committee will use in determining your eligibility. Give careful thought about who would best reflect your abilities and accomplishments so that your best efforts are reflected in your letters of support.

The advisory committee seeks the most diverse class possible (geographic representation, gender, ethnic background, sector, etc.). Due to the competitive application process and limited class size, interested individuals are encouraged to apply again if they are not accepted. All applicants will be contacted regarding the advisory committee's decisions by mid-May.

Tuition

Leadership Maine's tuition for the 2012-2013 program is \$ 3,500 for members of the Maine Development Foundation and \$ 4,500* for non-members. Tuition includes program costs, materials, meals, and facilities for the orientation, the seven sessions of the program (13 days), and the graduation. **Travel expenses to and from the sessions and lodging after the opening retreat are not covered in the tuition.**

To demonstrate personal commitment to the program, each participant is personally responsible for a minimum of \$200 of the tuition cost.

Regardless of the amount of financial support, your employer must support your full participation in the program (allowing adequate time away from other duties).

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Application Instructions

1. Ask two colleagues to write a letter of support for your participation in *Leadership Maine*. **These letters should attest to your leadership capacity and record of accomplishment. Think carefully about who should write these letters of support, and discuss with them the elements that you would like them to include in the letter. These are the best indicators that the selection committee has and are the most important element in the process. Letters should be returned to you well before the April 20 application deadline or can be sent directly to the Maine Development Foundation.** If you are not the CEO of your organization, one letter should be from your employer.
2. If you require financial assistance in order to participate in *Leadership Maine*, the funding plan worksheet is included in this packet. The worksheet should be returned to MDF with your application. **No financial information will be shared with the advisory committee throughout the selection process.**
3. **Return your completed application to the Maine Development Foundation, 295 Water Street, Ste. 5, Augusta, ME 04330 by April 20, 2012.** A completed application consists of:
 - ~ an application
 - ~ an updated resume
 - ~ two letters of support (#1 above)
 - ~ if financial assistance is needed, your funding plan (#2 above)
 - ~ a \$40 non-refundable, application fee (payable to Maine Development Foundation)
